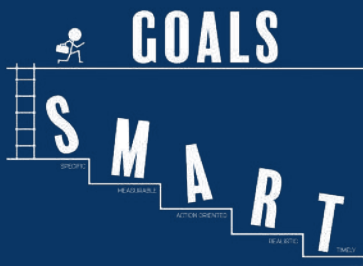

sharing, collecting feedback through Google Forms and written suggestions dropped into the suggestion Box and 1% of fun-filled celebrations with singing & dancing.

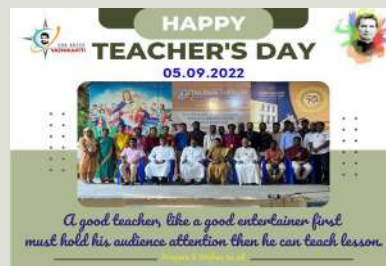


The 2nd batch for this FY 2022-23 was inaugurated on 1st August 2022. 40 Students along with their parents participated in the orientation program.
